Training Course Bookings

Terms & Conditions

- 1. The full course/tuition fee is payable at the time of booking.
- 2. A minimum of five participants is required for courses to be run. Courses not achieving this size may be rescheduled.
- 3. In the event of unsuitable weather the affected part of the course may be rescheduled.
- 4. Please note, once a booking is made, we are unable to give refunds; however places can be swopped with another child of a similar age and ability.
- 5. In the event that a course participant, through illness or otherwise, misses the start of (or any other part of) the course, Silver Wing Sailing Club are under no obligation to offer completion of the course or any refund or to transfer the booking.
- 6. Personal insurance is the responsibility of the course participant. Course participants are advised to take out personal insurance for any courses to cover the event of missing the course, cancellation, curtailment, personal injury, accident, damage to (or loss of) personal equipment or any other reason either caused by the course participant or beyond their control.
- 7. Course participants using their own equipment do so at their own risk and Silver Wing Sailing Club will accept no liability for damage or loss howsoever caused and must have suitable insurance cover and minimum buoyancy.
- 8. Silver Wing Sailing Club reserves the right to vary course details, dates and prices without prior notice.
- 9. A 'Health and Water-confidence Declaration' must be completed prior to the start of the course. This will be held by the Senior Instructor of the course and securely destroyed after the course is complete.
- 10. All course participants and visitors with the course participant will adhere to the SWSC Bye-laws and Code of Conduct.
- 11. It is the responsibility of the individual to inform the activity leader of any relevant medical condition or previous injuries that the course organiser should be aware of any, which may affect safe participation in the activity.
- 12. It is your responsibility to ensure you fully understand the exact nature of each activity you undertake, the risks involved and the equipment needed for safe participation. Please be aware that the nature of water sports does involve some risk to participants. You are assured that all reasonable precautions are taken by our coaching staff to minimize the risk; therefore it is essential that all instructions given by the training team be adhered to as requested.
- 13. Silver Wing Sailing Club will not accept any liability for any damage to or loss of property.
- 14. At times photographs or video footage of groups/individuals may be taken, under the direction of a senior member of SWSC staff, strictly for the purposes of coaching, recording events and for general promotional interest on

and off the water. No identifying information, other than names, will be included in the publication of such images. I consent to such images being published on the SWSC website, within SWSC premises and/or within SWSC advertising.

- 15. First aid will be administered in the event of it being required.
